The January 9th, 2017 meeting was brought to order by Chris Rodgers with the pledge of allegiance.

Old Business:

New Business:

It was suggested that the bank account be set up as a corporate account with different categories of funds. Set up a tax fund so the taxes can be set aside and not spent.

Chris Rodgers talked to Bob Chapup from Boy Scouts of America. They would like to use the front field for some of their events. For the boy scouts to shoot at the range there needs to be a NRA Qualified Instructor , and 2 Range Officers. The nearest class is in Missouri. Paul Adams is a NRA Qualified Instructor. This would be a good way to involve the Club in the community. Amy Stanley would like her Pack 610 Bears to use the facility January 17th. A police officer will do a safety class and finger printing.

Ken Pullins asked did Kerri Milhouser give Kim Rodgers all the past paperwork for the Secretary position. Kim Rodgers stated that she has not received anything.

Kerri Milhouser set up the insurance paperwork with Flaugh Insurance Co.
